A Tribute To My Father

My dad, Philip Nishikawa was born on the first day of Spring... March 20, 1939. He was born in Sacramento, at the same hospital as my son Miles, the old Sutter Memorial Hospital. That was 76 years ago, but on January 12th, 2016, my father's life was cut too short. He suffered a massive heart attack in his living room floor in Pleasanton. Phil was the eldest of four children, born just before World War Two broke out and his family was placed in an internment camp in Rohwer, Arkansas. After the war, my grandparents became farmers in Yuba City. My grandmother told me they were so poor and couldn't rely on the perfect farming weather that they pressured my dad to get a higher education. Philip not only hit the books, he



graduated in 1957 as the salutatorian at Yuba City High School and he went on to earn his degree in Engineering at Cal Berkeley. School came easy for my father. He was one of the smartest men I knew. He could help me with any math problem and explain it to me so I would understand numbers. He was an expert at word problems and showed me how to break down the sentences so I can understand the questions. He remembered chemistry formulas as if he wrote the book on Chem 101. I would often say to myself, "Why did I not get his brains!!!" My dad knew my gift was "gab" and embraced it. He was so excited when I was crowned homecoming queen at my all-white high school in Fremont... he saved this picture of us in his office and placed it in a crisp white envelope. He was elated when I got my first job in television reporting... and who cares if I was on a faraway island reporting from Guam. He thought I was Connie Chung (without the million dollar salary). My dad was very special to me, because he was the dad that gave you whatever you wanted... a new car when you turn 16... spending money to buy Gloria Vanderbilt and Calvin Klein jeans... but most importantly.. he would make sure my sister and I did not suffer the prejudices that he suffered as a child growing up as a Japanese American. My dad would not tolerate anyone calling us racial names or teasing us because of our race or ethnicity. He was always our bodyguard. And now with my dad in heaven, I feel he's still watching over me. But this time he has wings... my guardian angel! Rest in peace Dad. I love you!
